PLEASE NOTE: Final approval of all Wild cards is made by the FIM. A Wild card ride is only granted upon written confirmation from the FIM to MA. The FIM and MA have the right to select any rider they deem appropriate for this event. Please note there are costs associated with applying for an FIM Wild Card, specific costs will be communicated once received from the FIM.

WSBK Rules & Regulations

The rules and regulations of WSBK vary from national events; it is the rider's responsibility to read and understand these rules and regulations which can be obtained from www.fim-live.com/en/ or by contacting MA.

One Event International Licence

A One Event International Licence is required to compete in this event (approx \$500.00). Once the FIM has approved the Wild Card nomination the FIM licence paperwork will be sent to the competitor to complete.

Requirement

To be eligible for consideration, wild cards must fulfil the following:

- Superbike: Minimum age is 18 years. Maximum age is 50 years as of the year the rider turns 50.
- Supersport: Minimum age is 16 years. Maximum age is 50 years as of the year the rider turns 50.
- Be aware of rules 1.11.6 to 1.11.9 of the 2017 FIM Superbike & Supersport World Championships Regulations.
- Must not have ridden in the event as a wild card on three previous occasions in the same class.
- Helmets must be of the full face type and conform to one of the recognised international standards:
 - Europe ECE 22-05 'P'
 - Japan JIS T 8133 : 2007
 - USA SNELL M 2010
 - Australian Standard helmets do not comply to FIM international standard.
