1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Brisbane MCC, hereafter called the Promoter will conduct the Australian Classic Dirt Track Championship for Classic solo and sidecar machines at the Mick Doohan Raceway, on 7th and 8th July 2018.

2. JURISDICTION

2.1 The abovementioned meeting has been authorized by Motorcycling Australia (MA) which has issued the MA Permit Number MA2027 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia Senior National and One Event Competition Licences. One Event Competition Licences are available via the Brisbane MCC – contact Colin Metcher 0459 122 090. To purchase a licence on-site competitors are responsible to provide the following: proof of practical competence, proof of knowledge of the rules, proof of a club membership, and ambulance cover. To prove competency in riding, you will need to provide proof of holding an MA licence within the last 10 years OR a current road licence OR proof of having attended an accredited training school. If you have not held an MA licence in the past 10 years, you will need to complete a knowledge test, which can be found here: <http://www.motorcycling.com.au/Portals/28/Documents/Riders/Rider%20forms/Senior%20Theory%20Test.pdf> Join the club of your choice OR you can join the Brisbane MCC on the day.

2.2 The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's) contained in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport (MoMs) available at www.ma.org.au, these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling Australia. By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws and instructions.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 Entries are now open and close last mail **Friday 22nd June 2018** addressed to Brisbane MCC 1 Mewsdale Row, Tallai, Qld, 4213, or on Nominate <https://www.nominate.com.au/mcycycle/Eventinfo.aspx?Event=974&EventList=14> by midnight 22nd June 2018. **Late entries will not be accepted.**

4.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Brisbane MCC, if such retention is approved by MA.

4.3 Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.

4.4 Entry fees will only be refunded if a rider informs the Race Secretary Brisbane MCC, in writing, 10 days before the event. A medical certificate is required if a rider withdraws less than 10 days before the event.

5. ENTRY FEE

5.1 \$110.00 for the first class, plus \$20.00 for each additional class entered

5.2 Payment by money order or cheque with postal entry or through Nominate only. Any fees for dishonoured cheques will be the responsibility of the entrant.

5.3 Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to the Brisbane MCC.

6. ENTRY PASSES

6.1 Each entrant will receive 2 free entries (Entrant and one guest/mechanic). In order to gain your free entry you are required to bring your Nominate receipt, or a copy of your entry form.

6.2 All others are charged: \$20.00 per car or \$10.00 per individual. Children 12 and under are free.

7. INSURANCE

7.1 National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.

7.2 Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

It is strongly recommended that competitors give consideration to taking out weekly benefits insurance.

9. SCRUTINEERING

9.1 Scrutineering will be 2pm to 4pm Friday 6th July and 7am to 8am Saturday 7th July.

9.2 Machines entered in the competition must have successfully passed a machine examination prior to taking part in practice, qualifying or racing. An MA decal will be placed on the front number plate to indicate that it has been successfully examined.

9.3 Current competition licences and full riding gear must be presented at scrutineering. Eligibility checks can take place at any time during the meeting. Machines which suffer accident damage in practice or race sessions must be re-examined before participating again.

9.4 In addition to supervising the pulling down and checking of machines after official protests have been received by the Clerk of Course in accordance with the GCRs, the Steward can order that any machine be measured and if this occurs the Scrutineer will supervise a team member to pull down any machine that has taken part in the event. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in this matter being referred to the Clerk of Course for further action.

9.5 Machines will not be sealed for later checking after the event. All machines that are to be pulled down and scrutineered will take place at the circuit before the machine is released by the Scrutineer. A member of the rider's team must be available at all times to carry out the strip down under the control of the Scrutineer. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in this matter being referred to the Clerk of Course for further action.

11. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS

11.1 To constitute a class for the purpose of gaining Championship status, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be as per MoMs 12.2.2.2

11.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and/or prizemoney, will be at the discretion of the Brisbane MCC subject to MA approval.

12. STARTS

Starting procedure will be: backward falling gates on a concrete pad.

13. RACE FORMAT

13.1 Practice will be one sighting lap plus two laps

13.2 Qualifying is not applicable

13.3 Racing will be five rounds each five laps. Note: The number of laps may be reduced at Stewards discretion

13.4 Scoring will be points as per the MoMS over five rounds

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be from 2:00pm Friday 6th July with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

16. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY

No prize money. MA medallions will be presented to the first 3 place getters in the Championship races. Awards will be presented to all classes.

17. PRESENTATIONS

Presentation will be held at the venue as soon as practical at the completion of racing. Location will be advised in final Instructions.

18. MACHINES AND RIDERS

18.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Classic Dirt Track and Motocross competition.

18.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.

18.3 Change of machine is allowed at Stewards discretion

19. RIDING NUMBERS

Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their registered riding number or their preferred riding number. All others will be allocated numbers at the Promoter's discretion.

All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCRs and must not contain any decals or advertising other than the required MA decal.

Back numbers are compulsory

20. GRID POSITIONS

Will be done via a peg draw

21: ENVIRONMENTAL MATS

An absorbent mat that measures a minimum of 500mm x 500mm must be placed underneath the engine/gearbox and fuel tank of any solo or sidecar while parked in the pit, paddock or work area.

22. RIDERS' BRIEFING

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors MUST attend. Details will be included in the final instructions.

23. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION

Approximately 650mtrs anti clockwise deco surface

24. TRACK INSPECTION

24.1 All competitors will be given the opportunity to walk and inspect the track prior to any on track participation. This inspection must be done on foot and competitors are reminded that service vehicles may be in operation on the circuit at this time.

24.2 Competitors who are not satisfied with any aspects of the track can present these concerns to the Clerk of Course if those concerns cannot be resolved, the competitor will be invited to withdraw from the meeting.

25. FACILITIES

Canteen, toilets and showers on site. Fuel, accommodation and shopping nearby.

26. NOISE

Noise testing may take place at any time at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer or the Clerk of Course. Refer to GCR Appendix C: Sound Emissions & fuel for details.

27. TYRES

No knobby, MX, sand or paddle tyre on rear wheels allowed.

28. ANTI-DOPING POLICY

28.1 All competitors, officials, mechanics, team personnel and officials are advised that drug testing may take place in accordance with MA's Anti-Doping Policy, as carried out by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority. Refer to GCR 11 for details.

28.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, ph: 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at discretion until the results of the tests are known.

29. DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING

All competitors, officials, mechanics, team personnel and officials are advised that random drug and alcohol testing may take place during the competition. Refer to GCR 11.27 for details on the Safety Policy – Drug and Alcohol testing.

30. CODE OF CONDUCT

All competitors, officials, mechanics, team personnel and officials and parents are reminded of MA's Code of Conduct contained within MA's Member Protection Regulations, found at www.ma.org.au, which is a guide to appropriate behavior at all motorcycle race meetings. This Code of Conduct applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

31. ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS AND SOCIAL MEDIA

All competitors, officials, mechanics, team personnel and officials are reminded of MA's Electronic Communications and Social Media Policy, found at www.ma.org.au, which sets out a framework for acceptable online behavior where communications involve fellow MA members, volunteers, officials, coaches, sponsors, partners, staff and any other connected persons.
