Have you ever wondered what your licence fee included?

Motorcycling Australia Insurance Limited (MAIL) is a wholly owned, captive insurance company - MA deals with MAIL as it would if the business was placed through a conventional insurer. On payment of your licence you are covered by MA Insurance Limited for both Personal Accident and Public & Products Liability Insurance at MA permitted activities and events.

The following information lists the breakdown of charges and explains where your money goes.

Remittance Advice (Breakdown of Charges)

State Controlling Body	35%	Contribution towards State initiatives including officials training (up to level 3), coach training (level 1), State Championship events, facilitating member queries and licenses and club development initiatives.
Motorcycling Australia	28%	Contribution towards National and International initiatives including funding for international teams, commissions, all publishing material (MoMS, Junior Kick Start, Permits etc), national championship events, Level 4 officials training, Level 2 coach training, commissions, member technical enquiries, rule enquiries, FIM training seminars, National Media and sport development initiatives.
Personal Accident Insurance	23%	Covers against injury as defined for covered persons whilst competing, engaged in and/or attending MA Permitted race events, practice sessions, functions and activities organised by clubs and SCB's. Details on the benefits are explained in Chapter 9 of the Manual of Motorcycle Sport.
Public & Products Liability	14%	Provides protection for your legal liability for personal injury, property damage or advertising liability that occurs as a result of an occurrence in connection with your club / SCB activity.
