<b>Rule GCR:</b>
Current 7 – 12 years up to 125cc Junior women 7 – 15 years up to 125 cc Should read <b>7 -12 years up to 200cc</b> <b>Junior women 7 – 15 years up to 200cc</b>
Note capacity for both these classes will be reduced to 125cc from 01/01/2013

<b>Interpretation:</b>
This is an error in the 2012 MOMS. The change from 200cc to 125 cc for the above classes was to be effective from 01/01/2013. For 2012 the 7 – 12 year class and the junior women's class 7 – 15 years can participate on machines up to 200cc
