<p><b><i>The Team Manager should:</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Be known to MA, the Motocross Commissioners and within the Motorcycle Community</li> <li>▪ Have no conflicts of interest, that is, be involved for team purposes only</li> <li>▪ Have some overseas experience/time prior to the Junior Motocross World Championship</li> <li>▪ Have a high degree of management/organisational skills (for team preparation and dealing with issues that arise)</li> <li>▪ Have good communication skills.</li> <li>▪ Be able to communicate effectively and liaise with MA staff and selected riders</li> <li>▪ Possess personal skills to deal with language barriers and a reasonably large numbers of people</li> <li>▪ Be able to manage stressful situations</li> <li>▪ Be computer literate and have email and internet access</li> <li>▪ Work within an allocated budget</li> <li>▪ High degree of reporting skills</li> <li>▪ Be able to assist with the gaining of sponsorship for the team and the riders</li> <li>▪ Be involved in liaising with industry and manufactures to gain support for riders</li> </ul>	<p><b><i>The Team Manager Responsibilities include:</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Work with MA staff to organise team requirements/budgets</li> <li>▪ Work with MA staff to provide riders with a checklist of expectations in regard to equipment, shared spares, tools, repairs &amp; maintenance of bike, financial responsibilities etc</li> <li>▪ Form part of the selection Panel to determine the team of riders</li> <li>▪ Develop a team culture among the riders</li> <li>▪ Provide a report of the event within one month after the event (i.e. results, team activities)</li> <li>▪ Provide a confidential report on rider/team behaviour in relation to the Code of Conduct in the team agreement</li> <li>▪ Ensure that bikes and riders meet FIM requirements</li> <li>▪ Organise Support crew, meetings and transportation of same</li> <li>▪ Ensure roster is in place in vehicles for riders</li> <li>▪ Ensure Australia his held in high regard by the FIM</li> <li>▪ Ensure responsible behaviour of all who attend the event and wear the MA logo.</li> </ul>
