## 1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Tamworth Motorcycle Club, hereafter called the Promoter will conduct Australian Senior Track Championships for Senior Track at the Quirindi Showground, on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

If the meeting has been postponed for the reason of force majeure the date will 24<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> July at Quirindi Showgrounds. If the rain date cannot be run in its entirety, but the meeting has reached 75% for all competitors, then a result may be declared by the steward based on the points at the time of the determination. If it has not reached 75%, then the event will be declared null and void and further decisions of status of this event are at the discretion of Motorcycling Australia.

## 2. JURISDICTION

2.1 The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling Australia which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit MA 2492 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia Senior National Competition Licences and for selected support classes One Event licence holders.

2.2 The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCRs) contained in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport (MoMS) available at [www.ma.org.au](http://www.ma.org.au), these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling Australia. By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws and instructions.

2.3 One Event Competition Licences are accepted for the following classes: ATV Open and ATV Open (Women only)

One event licences are available for purchase online prior to the event via Ridernet.

One Event Competition Licences are available to Australian residents under the following conditions.

- (a) Licence will be available to all applicants 16 years and over.
- (b) Proof of Medicare or private health cover, including hospital stay required
- (c) Proof of ambulance cover required
- (d) Current MA affiliated club membership is required.
- (e) No competency test is required if the applicant can prove that they have held an annual competition licence within the previous 10 years.
- (f) Applicants who have never held a competition licence, or who have not held a licence within the previous 10 years must undertake a competency test.

**Competitors must provide the following to the Race Secretary at Sign-On to validate the One Event Licence:**

- proof of practical competence\*
- proof of knowledge of the rules
- proof of a MA affiliated club membership
- ambulance cover

\*To prove competency in riding, you will need to provide proof of holding an MA licence within the last 10 years OR a current road licence OR proof of having attended an accredited training school. If you have not held an MA licence in the past 10 years, you will need to complete a competency test. [The competency assessment may be undertaken at the permanent activity at which the participant intends to compete.](#)

**If the required documentation is not provided to validate the one event licence, the one event licence will be deemed invalid and the competitor will not be eligible to compete. A refund will not be issued for the One Event Licence if a competitor fails to provide the required documentation to validate the licence.**

### 4. ENTRIES

4.1 Entries are now open and close last mail Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2021. Late entries will not be accepted.

4.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Tamworth Motorcycle Club, if such retention is approved by MA.

4.3 Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.

4.4 Entry fees will only be refunded if a rider informs Tamworth Motorcycle Club in writing, 10 days before the event. A medical certificate is required if a rider withdraws less than 10 days before the event.

### 5. ENTRY FEE

5.3 Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to the Tamworth Motorcycle Club. Any fees for dishonoured cheques will be the responsibility of the entrant.

5.4 Please note: all final instructions will be posted on our clubs Facebook page.

6. ENTRY PASSES 6.1 NO ENTRY PASSES ISSUED ALL RIDERS NAMES WILL BE AT THE GATE UPON ENTRY INTO THE SHOWGROUND.

## 7. INSURANCE

7.1 National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.

7.2 Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

It is strongly recommended that competitors give consideration to taking out weekly benefits insurance.

## 8. MEDICAL SERVICES

Beneficial & Safety Medical Services will be in attendance from 10am on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> May 2021 and 10am on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

## 9. SCRUTINEERING

9.1 Scrutineering will begin at 7am on Saturday the 29<sup>th</sup> May 2021 and 7am on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

9.2 Machines entered in the competition must have successfully passed a machine examination prior to taking part in practice, qualifying or racing. An MA decal will be placed on the front number plate to indicate that it has been successfully examined.

9.3 Current competition licences and full riding gear must be presented at scrutineering. Eligibility checks can take place at any time during the meeting. Machines which suffer accident damage in practice or race sessions must be re-examined before participating again.

9.4 In addition to supervising the pulling down and checking of machines after official protests have been received by the Clerk of Course in accordance with the GCRs, the Steward can order that any machine be measured and if this occurs the Scrutineer will supervise a team member to pull down any machine that has taken part in the event. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in this matter being referred to the Clerk of Course for further action.

9.5 Machines will not be sealed for later checking after the event. All machines that are to be pulled down and measured will take place at the circuit before the machine is released by the Scrutineer. A member of the rider's team must be available at all times to carry out the strip down under the control of the Scrutineer. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in this matter being referred to the Clerk of Course for further action.

Riders are eligible to enter one class above capacity of the machine entered (SENIOR RIDERS ONLY)  
If not enough 250cc Sliders enter to constitute a championship class they will ride with 500cc Slider class.

## 11. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS

11.1 To constitute a class for the purpose of gaining Championship status, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be Ten (10) or more starters for Solos which actually participate in practice, qualifying and races. Six (6) or more starters for sidecars and six (6) or more starters for ATV's and six (6) or more starters for all female classes which actually participate in practice, qualifying and races.

11.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and/or prizemoney, will be at the discretion of the Tamworth Motorcycle Club, subject to MA approval.

## 12. STARTS AND FINISHES

## 13. FLAGS AND SIGNALS

As per Appendix B: Flags and Signals of MoMS.

## 14. RACE FORMAT

14.1 All competitors shall be given two (2) laps per rider for practice.

**Please note: Due to the length of the track, the number of laps have been reduced to allow for the additional length in the track.**

14.2 Where there are twelve (12) or less Solo entries per class, the Championship will comprise of five (5) races of three (3) laps. Points accumulated by each competitor in the five (5) races will determine final placings.

14.3 Where there are six (6) or less Sidecars and six (6) or less ATV entries, the event will comprise of five (5) races over three (3) laps. Points accumulated by each competitor in the five (5) races will determine final placings.

14.4 Where there are more than twelve (12) Solo competitors entered and competing in a class the Championship shall comprise of:

- Threer (3) qualifying heats of three (3) laps
- One (1) repechage race of three (3) laps
- One (1) final race comprising of four (4) laps

14.5 The repechage will be contested by competitors who finish 11<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> inclusive during the course of heats.

14.6 The right to compete in the final will be filled by:

- The ten (10) competitors accumulating the highest number of points during the course of the heats;
- The first two (2) placings of the repechage. The finishing order of each competitor in the final will determine the Championship placings.

14.7 Where there are more than six (6) sidecars and more than six (6) ATV's entered and competing in a class the Championships shall comprise of:

- Three (3) qualifying heats of three (3) laps
- One (1) repechage of three (3) laps; and
- One (1) final race comprising of four (4) laps

14.8 The repechage will be contested by competitors who finish 6<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> inclusive during the course of heats.

14.9 The right to compete in the final will be filled by:

- The five (5) competitors accumulating the highest number of points during the course of the heats;
- The first (1) placing of the repechage. The finishing order of each competitor in the final will determine the Championship placings.

14.10 All races will be scored using the score system as per the GCR's.

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, As of January 1 2021, 'in-competition' begins at 11:59 pm the night before an athlete is scheduled to compete and finishes at the end of the sample collection period for that competition.

## 16. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY

MA Medallions will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place overall in Championship classes and prize money for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> placings.

Support Classes: Juniors will receive 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place awards. Senior Support will receive prizemoney.

## 17. PAYG

PAYG Withholding affects the payment of prizemoney. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 46.5% of prizemoney over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

## 18. PRESENTATIONS

Presentation will be held straight after racing at the canteen area on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2021

## **19. MACHINES AND RIDERS**

19.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Track competition

19.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.

19.3 Change of machine is allowed only if the bike hasn't been raced in the same class of competition but only after the rider notifies the Clerk of the Course and the machine has successfully passed scrutineering for that event.

19.4 Scrutineered machines must remain in the pit area at all times between races and can only be removed at the conclusion of the event or with the permission of the Clerk of Course. Failure to comply will result in exclusion from the meeting.

19.5 The first five place getters must remain impounded in the selected area at the conclusion of the meeting for a period of 30 minutes to allow for eligibility protest to occur. During this time, no machine in the classes impounded shall be removed from the selected area. Failure to comply with the regulation will result in the matter being referred to the COC for further action.

## **20. RIDING NUMBERS**

20.1 Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their registered riding number or their preferred riding number. All others will be allocated numbers at the Tamworth Motorcycle Club discretion.

20.2 All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCRs and must not contain any decals or advertising other than the required MA decal.

20.3 Back numbers are compulsory as per GCRs– No senior or junior may compete in any competition unless wearing the machine identification number on the back with a minimum size of 125mm height and 20mm width of stroke. Figures must be black on a white background.

## **21. GRID POSITIONS**

21.1 Grid positions will be pre-drawn and listed in program.

21.2 Grid positions for all Repercharge and finals will be highest point scorer choosing 1<sup>st</sup> and so on down to 12<sup>th</sup> place.

## **22. RIDERS' BRIEFING**

All riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors MUST attend. Details will be included in the final instructions.

## **23. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION**

The circuit is a 760 meters oval trotting track with watered decomposed granite sand.

## **24. TRACK INSPECTION**

24.1 All competitors will be given the opportunity to walk and inspect the track prior to any on track participation. This inspection must be done on foot and competitors are reminded that service vehicles may be in operation on the circuit at this time.

24.2 Track Dissatisfaction - Competitors who are not satisfied with any aspects of the track can present these concerns to the Clerk of Course if those concerns cannot be resolved, the competitor will be invited to withdraw from the meeting.

## **25. FACILITIES**

Canteen, Toilets and Hot Showers will be available for use at the venue.

## **26. SOUND**

Sound testing will be conducted by a Noise Control Officer and may take place at any time at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer or the Clerk of Course. Refer to MoMSs Appendix C: Sound Emissions and Fuel.

## **27. PROTECTIVE CLOTHING**

## **28. TYRES**

As per GCRs Tyres and Rims

Speedway or Universal Trial Black pattern tyres are to be used.

- a) For machines 85cc and over, rear knobby tyres are not permitted,
- b) Front tyre types are optional

19" track tyres are permitted for use at all events on rim width not exceeding 3.5" front and rear.

## **29. ANTI-DOPING POLICY**

29.1 All competitors, mechanics, team personnel and officials are advised that drug testing may take place in accordance with MA's Anti-Doping Policy under the authority of Sport Integrity Australia. Refer to MA website for details.

29.2 Athletes are advised to download the Sports Integrity Australia app. If athletes have any doubts over Sports Integrity Australia requirements, they should visit the website [www.sportintegrity.gov.au](http://www.sportintegrity.gov.au)

It is recommended athletes contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline (1300 027 232) for further information. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed, at the discretion of MA, until the results of the tests are.

## **30. DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING**

All competitors, mechanics, team personnel and officials are advised that random drug and alcohol testing may take place during the competition. Refer to MA website for details on the Integrity Policy – Drug and Alcohol testing..

## **31. CODES OF BEHAVIOUR**

All competitors, mechanics, team personnel, officials and parents are reminded of MA's Codes of Behaviour contained within MA's Member Welfare Policy, found at [www.ma.org.au](http://www.ma.org.au), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. All competitors must have a minimum 2kg, dry power A:B (E) class, working fire extinguishers in their pit area.

### Waiver Agreement

#### Recitals

- A. The Provider organises, and permits participants to participate in, the Recreational Activity in consideration for the Participant:
- If a rider, paying the Application Fee; and
  - If a volunteer official volunteering to officiate at the Recreational Activity;
  - If a member of the media, accepting the Provider's terms of media accreditation; and
- otherwise agreeing to be bound by the Provider's rules and directives governing the conduct of the Recreational Activity.
- B. This document is the contract between the Provider and the Participant with respect to the Participant's participation in the Recreational Activity.
- C. The purposes of this contract include to:
- exclude the liability of the Provider to the extent permissible by law to pay damages or any other form of compensation whether arising in tort contract or statute or at law or in equity for any personal injury or death of the Participant as a result of the participant's participation in the Recreational Activity; and
  - provide a warning of the risks of engaging in the Recreational Activity (as defined below).
- D. Participating in the Recreational Activity is dangerous. The risks include but are not limited to death, serious injury or illness due to:
- falling from your bike;
  - difficult terrain and obstacles;
  - hazardous and changeable track conditions;
  - rider error and/or lack of skill or care and/or dangerous or reckless behaviour on your part or the part of other participants;
  - undisclosed medical conditions;
  - decisions made or not made by organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings;
  - heat, cold, wet or other adverse weather conditions;
  - contact with vehicles, other participants or members of the public who may or may not be acting safely;
  - lack of access to medical, evacuation or search services; or
  - design of the track.

#### Operative parts

- In consideration for me (the Participant) paying or providing the consideration under clause A above to participate in the Recreational Activity, the Provider will permit me to participate in the Recreational Activity.
- I acknowledge that the Recreational Activity involves the risk of serious injury, physical harm or death. I warrant that I am aware that the Recreational Activity involves the risk of serious injury, physical harm or death.
- I also acknowledge that in signing this contract I have done so voluntarily and that no pressure or unfair tactics have been used to persuade me to sign this contract and that I have done so voluntarily in the knowledge that it is open to me not to sign the contract and for the Provider to refuse to permit me to participate in the Recreational Activity. I also warrant that I have been given sufficient opportunity to read this contract before signing it and that I have read it.
- I agree that the Provider and any directors or officers of the Provider and any person associated with organising the Recreational Activity shall not be liable to me or any other person for damages, compensation or loss, whether in tort, contract, under statute or at law or in equity or otherwise for any personal injury or death caused by, or in connection with, or arising out of, my participation in the Recreational Activity.

#### Definitions

**Application Fee** means the fee payable by the Participant (as a rider) to participate in the Recreational Activity.

**Participant** means the person signing this form and whose name appears next to Participant below.

**Provider** means those persons and entities listed in Annexure 1.

**Recreational Activity** means the event specified in Annexure 2.

#### Participant acknowledgements, consents and authorisations

- I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to only participate in the Recreational Activity if I am fit and able to do so.
- I acknowledge that I am responsible for all medical, hospital and ambulance expenses arising out of my participation in the Recreational Activity save for any benefits provided by MA's Personal Accident Policy.
- I authorise and consent to the Provider arranging any medical, hospital or ambulance services on my behalf if necessary arising out of my participation in the Recreational Activity.



- iv. I authorise and consent to the Provider collecting and using my personal information for the purpose of administering the Recreational Activity and in accordance with the MA Privacy Policy.
- v. I authorise and consent to the Provider collecting my private health information from me and from any person or entity providing me with medical, hospital or ambulance services arising out of my participation in the Recreational Activities, and to the use of such information to reduce the risks to persons participating in recreational activities, in accordance with the MA Privacy Policy.
- vi. I acknowledge that I have agreed to, and am bound by, the Provider's rules and directives governing the conduct of the Recreational Activity, including the MA anti-doping policy and understand that I may be subject to drug testing.
- vii. I authorise and consent to photographs and electronic images (images) being taken of me in the course of the Recreational Activity. I have no proprietary interest in the images. I authorise and consent to the Provider using such images, my name and information about my participation in the Recreational Activity to promote the Provider or any recreational activities organised by the Provider.
